## **Important Notice to the candidates for various non-teaching posts**

1. The Paper -1 Question Paper Instructions for the post of Scientific Assistant (regular) and Scientific Assistant on Contract and Paper -2 Question Paper Instructions for the post of Scientific Assistant (regular) are given below.
2. For the post of Scientific Assistant (regular) and Scientific Assistant on Contract, the OMR format for Paper -1 Exam with instructions is given below.
3. Non-scientific calculator is allowed in Paper-1 & 2 for the post of Scientific Assistant (regular) and Scientific Assistant on Contract
4. Videography shall be done for the written exam scheduled on 12-11-2022.
5. Last Entry of Candidate shall be allowed up to 09:45 AM at Main Gate.
6. No candidate shall be permitted to enter in the Exam Hall after 10:00 AM.
7. Minimum cut off marks shall be 50 out of 100 marks (Paper-1) for the post of Scientific Assistant on Contract.
8. Minimum cut off marks shall be 60 out of 125 marks (Paper-1 & 2) for the post of Scientific Assistant (regular).

**Updated Instructions to be followed by the candidates inside Examination Hall for the written exam scheduled on 12-11-2022**

**Before the written test begins:**

- a) List of candidates showing their allotted rooms, seats, roll numbers, will be pasted at conspicuous places at the Lecture Hall Complex, IISER Mohali. Candidates should find and sit only at the seat allotted to them inside the examination hall.
- b) Candidates appearing for the written test from a room or seat other than the one allotted to them will have their candidature cancelled.
- c) The invigilator will communicate the important instructions to be followed during the exam.
- d) A Question booklet and an OMR sheet will be provided to candidates in Paper-1.
- e) A Question booklet having space to write answers for descriptive questions will be provided to the candidates who are appearing for Paper-2.
- f) Candidates must open the question booklet only after the commencement of the written test.
- g) Candidates should ensure that the question booklet contains as many pages as mentioned on the cover page. In case of any discrepancy, candidates must inform the invigilator on an immediate basis.

**Dress code:**

- a) Shirts or tops must be open at the neck.

**Documents allowed inside Exam Hall:**

- a) Call letter/Admit Card after affixing your self-attested coloured photograph at the space provided in the Call letter/Admit Card.
- b) One valid photo ID proof such as Aadhar Card, Voter Card, Driving Licence, etc.
- c) The aforementioned documents will be checked and verified by the invigilator inside the exam hall.

**During the written test:**

- a) Candidates carrying any of the barred items except non-scientific calculator (mobile phone, camera, bluetooth device, digital watch, wired or wireless earphones, or any electronic device) inside the exam hall will not be allowed to take the written test.
- b) Candidates should remain in their respective seats.
- c) Candidates should remember to sign the attendance sheet.
- d) Providing or taking help from other candidates is not allowed. Candidates found cheating and using any unfair means will be disqualified.
- e) No candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall before the time/end of the written test.
- f) Pens will be provided by the Institute to all candidates. Candidates are not allowed to use his/her pen during the exam (Paper-1 & 2)

**Attendance Sheet:**

- a) Candidates must remember to sign the attendance sheet in the examination hall.

**At the end of the written test:**

- a) The invigilator will inform the end of the exam. Candidates must stop answering questions after the conclusion of the exam.

- c) Candidates who are appearing in Paper-2 shall hand over the Question Booklet to the invigilator at the end of the exam.

**Unfair Means:**

The following are considered as the use of unfair means (U.F.M):

- a) Carrying OMR sheet and Question Booklet of Paper-2 outside the exam hall.
- b) Tearing the Question booklet and OMR sheet.
- c) Writing answers on anything other than the OMR sheet.
- d) Cheating and asking/providing help to other candidates.
